After lunch we visited the Chi Town Union Station Toy Train display at 8275 Cooley Lake Road in Commerce Township a few miles North of the Restaurant. This place is a must see if you have any interest in toy trains:













The electronics that run this place are amazing. Up to twenty five trains (25) can be simultaneously controlled by one very large computer and associated electronics system. The signals are coded so that each train only receives its own intended signal (from the common rails) and none of the 25 trains crash into each other??!! Each train engine is custom built to adapt to the electronics ... no store bought engines in this display.

One of these trains was a coal train with 111 cars and three engines. You have to see this toy train operation in person to believe it. This train club is very dedicated and talented ... the detail level of both the trains and the scenery is quite impressive. The size of the layout takes up the whole area of this former medium size drug store building.
